Jones given the time to make Bluebirds fly

Cardiff City chairman Peter Ridsdale wants his manager Dave Jones to become the next Sir Alex Ferguson.

He has promised Jones two things - patience and time to build.

Jones has been at the club since 2005 and the progress has been impressive.

Cardiff have a new training facility, and will move to a state-of-the-art stadium in 2009.

Improvements on the pitch are noticeable too, with City pushing for promotion.

And Jones has been awarded the Coca-Cola Championship Manager of the Month award for January, after a run of five wins and a draw to kick off an exciting new year.

Chairman Ridsdale said: "We have a manager who we have told we are going to give time. Why? Because it is the only way you are ever going to build anything."

"Look at Sir Alex Ferguson. It took him time to win his first title at United. The

future of this club is looking good."

Jones admits he is loving his time in the Principality.

He said: "As a manager you watch the merry go round, and you know you are in a precarious job."

"But the two things you

rarely get in football are time and patience.

"If United had never given that to Alex Ferguson he would never have achieved what he has."

"I am the second longest-serving manager in this division, and I've only been

here two and a half years.

"It's crazy. I love building teams though and I am pleased to have the opportunity to do that here from scratch. You don't normally get that chance."

Coca-Cola Awards Panel Chairman Chris Kamara said: "Dave completed a great month by beating QPR 3-1. Last season they drifted away at the start of the new year - but this will give him optimism that they can push for promotion."

"And now to be called back to Peterborough - well, that's really where I want to be playing."

"My aim at the start of this season was to break into the first team, and so hopefully now I can do it."

Potter has been nominated among four players to become to Player of the Round, and wins a day at Wembley for the FA Cup Final if he comes out on top.

Three chairs for Adam as he rides for charity

Rearly cheeky, Gary

Wycombe Wanderers fan Adam Hayward cycled 161 miles to an away game to raise cash for charity.

He set off to the match against Rotherham on behalf of the charity called Rob's ARTTT.

The initials stand for A Rare Teenage Tumour Trust. It was set up by Wanderers supporter Rob Holland, who sadly died in September of a tumour cancer that only affects teenage males.

Rob was determined to raise £100,000 to fund research into the condition.

Adam, 19, battled through treacherous conditions for three days as he rode from Wycombe to South Yorkshire.

And the trip was worthwhile as he raised over £2,000 for the cause - and saw his side snatch a 1-1 draw thanks to Scott McGleish's equaliser.

Chairboys season-ticket holder Adam said: "I got to know Rob's dad through

previous fund-raisers and read up about the charity on its website.

"It's not just about raising money but sharing the charity with other people. It's such a rare form of cancer there's no current research going on in this country. I plan to raise as much money as I can.

"I was going to cycle along canal tow paths. I had to re-route because they were all flooded and the wind was picking up!"

Adam works as a chef at the Chiltern Hospital and arranged a Mexican theme day in the restaurant with all profits going towards his sponsorship.

Rob's dad Chris said: "Since June we have raised around £50,000, and what Adam did was just brilliant.

"I'm chuffed to bits. My lad would have been giving the thumbs up.

"People have been doing all sorts of things for us. Some even jumped out of planes."

10 still in Cup

The Football League has taken a hold on this season's FA Cup - with 10 clubs still in the competition.

The Championship is represented by Barnsley, Southampton, Cardiff, Wolves, Sheffield United, Preston, Coventry and West Brom.

The League 1 outfits still standing are Huddersfield and Bristol Rovers.

For only the fourth time in history at the Fifth Round stage there are just six teams remaining from the top-flight.

The record for the fewest top division sides in the Fifth Round was set in 1957/58, when only Bolton, Manchester United, Sheffield Wednesday, West Brom and Wolves were left.

This season's Fifth Round ties take place on February 16 and 17.

Millwall were the last League side to make it to the Final. The Lions were beaten 3-0 by Manchester United in
