Striker Adam Birchall suggested the idea to club captain Lee Harrison, who talked it over with manager Paul Fairclough.

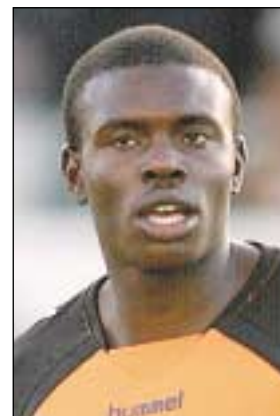
September's League 2 Manager of the Month told his keeper: "Get it organised."

And the result? Barnet are unbeaten in six games since the policy came in at the end of August - and only one of the five yellow cards they received in September was for dissent.

This is in stark contrast to the opening week of the season when they received three red and eight yellow cards.

Harrison said: "Only team skipper Ismail Yakubu can talk to the referee about decisions.

"There is no kicking the ball away or crowding referees. This works for us - just look at our results."

Tony putting Baggies back in the big time

Tony Mowbray is proof that losing a Play-Offs Final - and £23million worth of talent - is not the end of the world.

In fact, the West Brom boss seems to be thriving on it.

He was named the Coca-Cola Championship Manager of the Month for September after his Baggies showed they have put their Wembley heartache and the summer departures of star names well and truly behind them.

He pipped Watford's Aidy Boothroyd and Bristol City's Gary Johnson to the award after Albion won four and drew one of their five League games last month.

Coca-Cola Ambassador and chair of the judges' panel Chris Kamara said: "It was a great month for Tony.

"When he took charge of



the club last season, he looked as though he felt it wasn't his team, but Bryan Robson's.

"But after some wheeling and dealing in the summer they now look like his team.

"Tony seems more settled and I think that's part of the reason his team are doing so well.

"It's never easy after losing a Play-Offs Final. But Albion have made The Hawthorns a fortress. And their 5-1 victory over QPR shows they are capable of scoring from all over the park."

Albion narrowly missed out on promotion when Derby

beat them 1-0 in last season's Play-Offs Final.

Mowbray then watched as Paul McShane, Jason Koumas, Diomansy Kamara and Curtis Davies left The Hawthorns for pastures new.

But the manager replaced them with the likes of Luton defender Leon Barnett, French midfielder Felipe Teixeira and Sheffield Wednesday's Northern Ireland star Chris Brunt.

Mowbray also signed Manchester City striker Ishmael Miller on loan, while evergreen marksman Kevin Phillips has scored six times this season. Phillips said:

"Yes, we lost four players but it's not the end of the world and I think we've shown so far they've not been a major miss for us.

"There were rumours that I was moving, but it was never in my head.

"The manager said he's only keen on players who want to be here and I'm definitely one of those because I know what he wants to achieve here.

"You can't stop players from leaving, but we've got players here now who are capable of pushing for promotion."

But Mowbray refuses to get carried away by his side's promising start.

He said: "In this league you are only a couple of results away from a crisis."

Lads have faith in the Wise man

Tresor Kandol is a born-again Christian who has put his faith in a Wise man.

And he is not the only disciple at Elland Road.

For Leeds striker Kandol insists the whole squad believes in manager Dennis Wise – and he most certainly believes in them.

And this mutual trust and belief has helped Leeds record the best start to a season in their history – and earn Wise a second successive Manager of the Month award.

Rejuvenated Kandol, who has netted five times this season, said: "This club looks after the players, and we've got a manager who does that as well.

"We have this understanding with the gaffer, and



that's the sort of thing that wants to make you stay at a club.

"Things are working out well, and that's what you want. I don't see any reason for me to go anywhere else.

"When you come into work you expect to have a good weekend and that's a really good feeling.

"We can't afford to have a quiet dressing room or people who don't believe – the manager won't allow that to happen.

"Leeds United can't be sitting in this division for long, and there is no time to waste.

"The changing room is buzzing. Things are totally different now. We've got a

different squad and there's a different feel around the place.

"The manager must take a lot of credit for that.

"We haven't lost a game yet and I feel very confident about everything that's going on.

"I still feel nervous going into games, but they're the right sort of nerves."

Wise netted the September honour after Leeds maintained their unbeaten record with four

wins and a draw from the month's five matches.

The West Yorkshire club wasted no time wiping out their 15-point deduction for breaching League rules and now have 10 points.

Former Leeds star Chris Kamara said: "What is going on at Leeds at the moment is simply phenomenal. Nobody could have predicted it at the start of the season.

"There's still a long way to go, but these are happy days at Elland Road."

Sir Alex backs stadium

Football's big guns are bringing pier pressure to bare...for Southend.

Sir Alex Ferguson is backing the Shrimpers' bid to build a new stadium.

So are Match of the Day stars Gary Lineker, Mark Lawrenson, Alan Shearer and Alan Hansen as well as Football League Chairman Lord Mawhinney.

The Manchester United manager and the players-turned-presenters have sent letters of support to the public inquiry into United's plans for a new 22,000 all-seater home at Fossetts Farm.

The inquiry at the Southend Civic Centre is expected to last for another week.

The proposed Fossetts Farm site is less than two miles from Roots Hall, where the capacity is just 12,392.

Who was the last England manager to win a trophy?

Hands up, all those who said: Alf Ramsey.

Well, the correct answer is, of course, Paul Fairclough.

The Barnet boss is also manager of the England Non-League team – recent winners of the 2007 Four Nations tournament. Fairclough has also picked up the Coca-Cola League 2 Manager of the Month award for September.

Fairclough's Bees, among the pre-season favourites for relegation, are sixth in the table after going unbeaten throughout the month.

Three wins and two draws helped Fairclough beat Paul Ince to the award – even though the MK Dons' boss saw his table toppers win



four of their five games.

Chris Kamara explained: "It was a difficult decision but we decided to give the award to Paul Fairclough because of the quality of the opposition Barnet faced during the month.

"Their three victories were against sides who came down last season – Bradford, Chesterfield and Rotherham.

"They also drew away at Dagenham and at home to Rochdale.

"On paper it looked as though it was going to be a very difficult month for Paul and his players, so to come through it unbeaten deserves recognition."

Fairclough, 57, has come

a long way in the 20 years since he took up his first managerial post at Non-League Hertford Town.

After making a name for himself at Stevenage, he was appointed Barnet boss in March 2004 and led them back into The Football League in his first full season in charge.

He admitted: "It has been a long journey, but that is why the pyramid system works – it allows people to realise their dreams." The Bees are

buzzing after Fairclough gave his squad a major overhaul in the summer.

He said: "I have changed the shape into a tighter unit and I am pleased with my signings.

"We have brought in hungry young players who are going to eat up this division and I expect us to be pushing for promotion.

"A good start is important. It is also important not to get down when you get a run of defeats because it happens."

Steve planning a peak challenge for charity

They say you have to be mad to be a goalkeeper. Steve Phillips is a case in point.

But the Bristol Rovers shot-stopper is mad...about fund-raising.

After running a half-marathon and staging a poker night to earn nearly £10,000 for his two favourite causes, Phillips is already planning his next big charity extravaganza.

He said: "I've been told about the Three Peaks Challenge which involves walking up the highest mountains in England, Scotland and Wales in three days, so I may go for that - possibly next summer.

"But whatever happens I won't be doing another half-marathon because it nearly killed me."

Phillips completed last month's 13-miler in Bristol in one hour and 55 minutes, despite getting injured 24 hours before the start in the match against Luton. He

admitted: "I got kneed in the back and was worried I wouldn't be able to do the race, but luckily the pain eased off overnight.

"I planned to walk most of the way but ended up running, which was probably a mistake.

"I couldn't even walk the following day, let alone do anything else. I couldn't run

the day after either!"

But the gain was worth the pain as he raised more than £8,000 for Sands - a charity which helps people who have had a stillborn child or lost a child in infancy - and Rovers fan Jamie Cooper, who was badly injured while serving as a soldier in Iraq.

Phillips bumped up the tally to an estimated £10,000

by staging a poker night at the Memorial Ground.

He added: "It's been fantastic. The willingness to put their hands in their pockets epitomises Bristol Rovers supporters.

"I just want to say a massive thanks to everyone who has donated to the two causes."
